

**STUDENT TRAVEL SUPPORT to the 26<sup>TH</sup> NAM (Chicago, June 23-28, 2018)**

**from the CANADIAN CATALYSIS FOUNDATION (CCF)**

The Canadian Catalysis Foundation is pleased to provide a partial travel support for graduate students from Canadian Universities to attend the 26<sup>th</sup> North American Catalysis Society Meeting in Chicago on June 23-28, 2018. The support will be provided on a competitive basis only to those students who applied for Kokes Award to present at the 26<sup>th</sup> NAM but were unsuccessful.

Incomplete or late applications will not be considered. The names of recipients will be listed on the Catalysis Division website [www.catalysisdivision.ca](http://www.catalysisdivision.ca) (and/or Newsletter). The support will be provided within 3 months after the close of the meeting in the form of a cheque made out to the student. Original receipts for travel will be required.

**Mandatory Conditions:**

- 1). The applicant (graduate student) must be enrolled in a thesis-based program in a Canadian University at the time of the application submission and the conference.
- 2). A graduate student must submit an abstract to 26<sup>th</sup> NAM and the application for Kokes Award as outlined on the 26<sup>th</sup> NAM website by the deadline (November 19, 2018, unless extended by the NAM's Organizing Committee).
- 3). A completed application form to CCF (below), the submitted abstract and the student's resume must be e-mailed to Natalia Semagina [semagina@ualberta.ca](mailto:semagina@ualberta.ca) (with a copy to the student's supervisor) **by the deadline of the Kokes Award application** (November 19, 2018, unless extended by the NAM's Organizing Committee).
- 4). Upon notifications of the abstract acceptance (oral or poster) and Kokes Award from the 26<sup>th</sup> NAM Committee (early 2019), if unsuccessful, these two confirmation emails must be forwarded to [semagina@ualberta.ca](mailto:semagina@ualberta.ca) within 5 business days of the announcement. The CCF awards committee will notify the CCF travel support winners and their supervisors by early registration deadline for the 26<sup>th</sup> NAM and will provide further instructions.
- 5). The student has to be present at the 26<sup>th</sup> NAM full time. Original travel receipts will be required.

**Application package for the CCF travel support:**

1. This completed form,
2. A single page resume, highlighting the student's accomplishments,
3. Abstract(s) submitted to the 26<sup>th</sup> NAM.

These three items must be compiled, in order, into a single pdf document and submitted to Natalia Semagina [semagina@ualberta.ca](mailto:semagina@ualberta.ca) (with a copy to the student's supervisor) **by the deadline of the Kokes Award application** (November 19, 2018, unless extended by the NAM's Organizing Committee).
